1. INTRODUCTION

Welcome! Thank you for your interest in Dele's School Visit; an engaging, story-based experience designed to inspire and support young children's development through storytelling, rhythm, and interactive learning. This pack will give you an overview of what to expect, how to prepare, and how your students can benefit from this joyful and educational session.

2. WHAT THE VISIT INCLUDES

- **Storytelling** – A live reading of Dele's inspiring story to spark empathy and imagination.
 - **Rhythm of Resilience** – A lively Djembe and percussion session that boosts confidence, focus, and participation.
 - **Little Hands of Advocates** – Children will reflect on the story, connecting with the characters' journey, they will practice early advocacy by finding real ways to help.
 - **Interactive Performance** – Children will connect with the book by matching its rhythm with a simple song and choreography.
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3. LEARNING OUTCOMES

Dele's School Visit supports multiple areas of child development and curriculum goals, including:

- Social-emotional learning
 - Communication and language
 - Creative expression and music
 - Listening and attention
 - Building confidence and empathy
 - Movement.
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4. HOW TO PREPARE

To help children get the most out of the visit:

- Set up a quiet space for the story
 - Clear an area for movement and drumming
 - Provide white paper and drawing tools for creative reflection
 - Brief the class on what to expect with rhythm and listening
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5. DJEMBE DRUMMING SESSIONS

(Optional Add-On) Djembe drumming supports children's emotional regulation, focus, and self-expression while promoting movement, rhythm, and coordination. Sessions are inclusive, engaging, and tailored to suit the needs of Early Years and Primary-aged children.

One-to-One Sessions

- 45 minutes – AED 250

Group Sessions (up to 10 children)

- 45 minutes – AED 1,000 flat rate

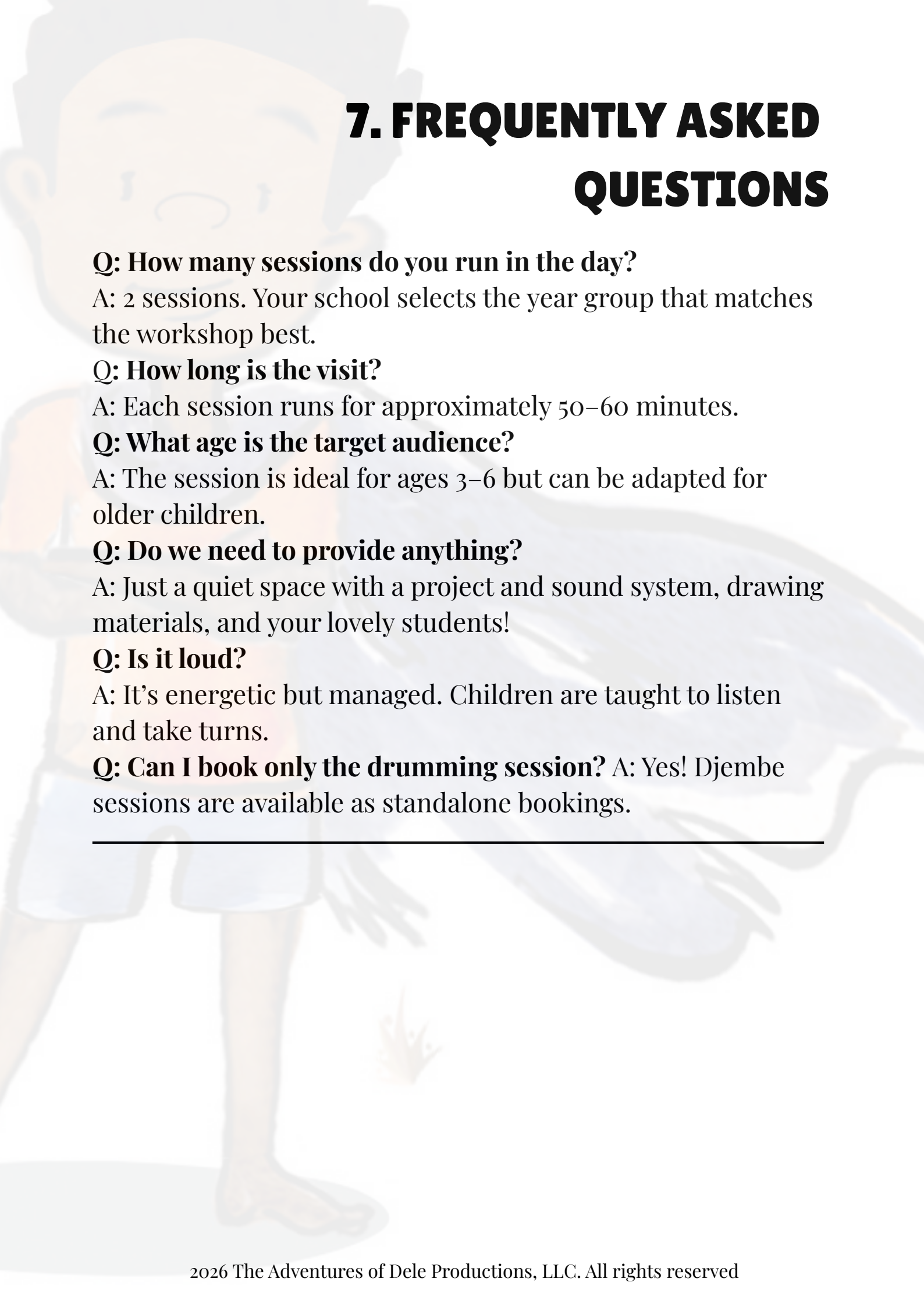

7. FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: How many sessions do you run in the day?

A: 2 sessions. Your school selects the year group that matches the workshop best.

Q: How long is the visit?

A: Each session runs for approximately 50–60 minutes.

Q: What age is the target audience?

A: The session is ideal for ages 3–6 but can be adapted for older children.

Q: Do we need to provide anything?

A: Just a quiet space with a project and sound system, drawing materials, and your lovely students!

Q: Is it loud?

A: It's energetic but managed. Children are taught to listen and take turns.

Q: Can I book only the drumming session? A: Yes! Djembe sessions are available as standalone bookings.
